RE: PURCHASE OF ROLL-OFF TRUCK

I am requesting approval for purchase of a used roll-off truck from the county for \$29,500.00. As you know, the county has purchased a new one and has offered to sell the city this 1995 Model Mack for the amount they were allowed for trade-in. The truck is in good mechanical condition and ready to use. Researched prices for this type and model ranged from \$38,000 and up, so this is a very good price. (FOR A USED VEHICLE) JS

The roll-off truck will be used to haul the City's recycle bins and our commercial customer's containers. Currently Wilson Brothers Disposal provides this service at a cost of \$82.00 per haul, approximately 50-60 times a month at a total cost of \$4000 - \$5000 a month. Purchase of a roll-off truck will eliminate these costs and allow us to use city personnel to carry out these services. It will also allow us to provide better maintenance of the recycling sites in keeping the containers emptied as needed and the areas clean.

Re: Ensor Park Project

Date: April 28, 2000

I just wanted to give you an update on the Ensor Park Project and where we are on the bidding process. I will be presenting the bids at the May 4th Council Meeting.

This project is part of the matching LPRF Grant monies we received from the State. Maffett Inc. designed the area as a natural park to serve as a model of good storm water management. We plan to include additional background information about the sink hole and its importance to the city. The total cost to the city is estimated at \$30,000 - the budgeted amount is \$42,000.

The project was bid in two different Bid Packages. Bid Package "A" includes the purchase and erection of a pre-engineered steel gazebo, construction of a wooden pedestrian bridge adjacent to existing roadway bridge, and construction of a masonry and stone coveled ring. Bid Package "B" consists of the construction of a drive entrance and parking lot.

Some of the remaining work will be done in-house, such as trail development, a small amphitheater, path for picnic tables, retaining wall for parking lot, repair and additions to security fence surrounding the sink hole and construction of entrance gate.
